2:45 PM - camp ends


Camps will be led by one of our lead teachers during the morning portion. The afternoon portion will be a structured group activity, such as crafts, games, etc., and will be led by the assistants.


Camp Cost

The cost for each weeklong camp session is \$350 and includes materials. Latchkey will be available for \$70 per day (8:05am-2:45pm, Before & After care rates still apply) on these dates: Monday, June 3rd – Friday, June 7th & Monday August 19th – Friday, August 23rd.

MRA requires a credit card or debit card/bank account on file. This card will be charged on the first business day of the month, unless payment is received prior.









A two-week minimum notice is required for any schedule changes. You will be charged 50% for any cancellations if 2 weeks' notice is given. If less than a 2 week notice is given, there will be no refund.

Summer invoices will go out the 4th week of the preceding month. Your account on file will be charged on the first business day of the month.

Latchkey Cost

Before & After Camp: 7:00 AM-8:05 AM & 2:45 PM-5:30 PM \$50/week Before & After Care costs also apply to the Latchkey weeks of June 3rd and August 19th.

It is the family's responsibility to obtain an Anoka Aquatic Center Pass <u>in your child's name</u>. Please check out the Anoka Aquatic Center's website for more information. **If you forget your gear**, your child will still accompany the rest of the class to the Aquatic Center but will not be allowed in the pool. **If you forget your Aquatic Pass**, MRA will buy a daily pass for your child and charge your account.

Non-MRA Students

Non-MRA students, such as siblings, are welcome to attend our summer program. An application and application fee of \$100 will be required to enroll for the summer. Our standard student paperwork packet will also be required prior to the child's first day with us. This includes but is not limited to emergency contact information, health care summary, and immunizations.



Aquatic Center Water Day 2024 For Upcoming Grade 2 & Up

We are excited to continue going to the Anoka Aquatic Center this summer! The upcoming Grade 2 & up students will go to the Aquatic Center weekly for Water Day. Upcoming 1st graders will stay at MRA for water day.

Due to the unpredictability of Minnesota weather, Water Day will be determined based on the conditions outside. Because of this change, Water Day gear needs to be brought at the beginning of every week and left at school. We will place a sign in the hallway by the computer when your child's water gear needs to be taken home. Please bring it back the next day, so that we can possibly have more than one water day each week.

We are looking for parent volunteers to help chaperone! While the Center does have lifeguards on hand, we are responsible for our own group so having parent volunteers to help us monitor the safety of the students while at the Aquatic Center is much appreciated.

Your child should come to school in regular clothing. Please do <u>not</u> send them in swimwear. The children will change into their swimsuits prior to leaving MRA. If the locker rooms are available, the children will change out of their swimsuits at the Aquatic Center. If not, they will walk back to MRA before changing out of their swimsuits.

For your child to attend, they will need...

- A season pass: This is the best option if your child will be in attendance consistently throughout the summer. If your child is only attending a few weeks throughout the summer, you can provide them with cash on the day to purchase a daily pass.
- ALL of the necessary water gear: swimsuit, towel, sunscreen (non-aerosol), outside shoes, swimsuit cover up/clothes, reusable bag (to carry all of their items)

If your child forgets their gear, they will still accompany the rest of the class to the Aquatic Center but will not be allowed in the pool. If your child forgets your Aquatic Pass, MRA will buy a daily pass for your child and charge your account.
