

## *Children's House Summer 2026*

Summer 2026 will run in two-week sessions with alternating themes. Families may sign up for individual weeks, or for the entire two-week session. If you sign up for an individual week, you are not guaranteed which theme your child will attend. Children signed up for the full two-week session will participate in both themes.

### ***Summer Camp Themes***

## ***Summer Camp Schedule***

8:05 AM – door opens

8:15 AM – camp begins, door closes

11:00 AM – lunch/recess

12:00 PM – camp resumes

12:30 PM – nap begins (if applicable)

2:30 PM – nap ends (if applicable)

2:45 PM – camp ends

Camps will be led by one of our lead teachers during the morning portion. The afternoon portion will be a structured group activity, such as crafts, games, etc., and will be led by the assistants. If your child naps, nap will begin after lunch/recess.

**Montessori Care will be available the week of June 29<sup>th</sup>. MRA will be CLOSED June 19<sup>th</sup> and July 3<sup>rd</sup>, as well as August 31<sup>st</sup>– September 4<sup>th</sup> for staff development, training, and orientation.**

## ***Camp Cost***

The cost for each camp week is \$350 and includes materials. There will be a \$10/week sibling discount on every child after the first if you have multiple children attending the same week. If you would like to pay for the entire summer in full by May 1<sup>st</sup>, a 5% discount will apply.

MRA requires a credit card or debit card/bank account on file. This card will be charged on the first business day of the month, unless payment is received prior.
